1. Hardware Installation

1.1 Device Mounting

1 Pole Mount



2. Thread through the hole of CP300 and ties the straps firmly on the pole.

Wall Mount



- 1. Drive the nail into the wall and make sure the nail position is exactly matching the device.
- 2. Hang the CP300 on the wall.

1.2 Network Connection



Note

- 1.Locate a suitable mounting site for your CPE. For choosing the best location, select an elevated location where trees, buildings and large steel structures will not obstruct the antenna signals and which offers maximum line-of-sight prop-agation with the users.
- Adjust the direction of your CPE for a best signal. Place the straps through the slots on the back of the CPE and then around the pole. Tighten the Straps.
- 3.Please make sure the two CPEs are placed face to face, otherwise the wireless signal strength might be weak.

1.3 Port, Button, LED Indicators Description



Port and Button	Description
LAN	This port is used to access RJ45 cable to connect to PoE Power Adapter, meanwhile realize data transmission.
Reset	With the CPE powered on, press and hold the button for about 10 seconds, the CPE will reboot to factory default settings.



LED Indicator	Description
POWER	The POWER LED will light blue when properly connected to a power source.
LAN	This Ethernet LED will light solid blue when an active Ethernet connection is made to the LAN port and flash when there is activity.
WLAN	This WLAN LED flash blue when the wireless function working.
Signal	These LEDs display the signal strength.

FAQ

1. How to reset the CPE to factory default Settings?

Keep the CPE powered on, press and hold the RESET button on CPE for about 8 seconds, then the CPE will be restored to the factory default settings.



2. What Can I do If I forgot the CPE's Web Login User Name and Password?
